- Few recommendations –

 - While practicing the questions, try to understand the reasoning behind a wrong answer and make sure to understand from it and fix your understanding going forward. Every single question teaches something.
 - Few imp concept to focus on – Cloud characteristics, CDN, SDN, SDDN, OWASP, GDPR, XML & API gateway, and Cloud-related ISO and NIST standards.
 - Take 5 min break after around 40 questions and completely distract yourself during that time.
 - *Choose an elimination technique a lot if you are unsure of the answer; your answer should be the one solving a problem and should be based on security practices.*
